How far will you go to deliver a message?

This week I read an interesting article about Jonny Beardmore who has embarked on a yearlong journey across seven continents to hand-deliver 50 postcards to their intended recipients.

Beardmore was inspired by a 200-year-old "post office" tradition in the Galápagos Islands. These islands sit far off the coast of Ecuador. Sailors would leave letters in a mailbox for their loved ones, hoping they would be collected and delivered by passing ships. Today, people still leave postcards there wondering if they will be delivered. In walks Beardmore.

He recently delivered a letter to Nashville. It was addressed to Lauren, whose parents had dropped it off in the Galápagos months ago. They sent it because it had a picture of a bird on it that they thought their grandson would enjoy.

Thus far Beardmore has delivered 20 postcards and traveled over 32,000 miles.

This got me thinking. What messages do we need to deliver? What do we need to say to the people we care about? Thankfully, we do not have to travel quite so far.
